Darren opens the discussion by mentioning how fast our date of June 18th is coming up and that we need to send a "Save the Date" email to our email list and start publicizing the event. Darren will get an email going and send a draft to us for review and comments shortly. He will make this password protected. We will plan on a meeting once a week to get plans pinned down. Darren wants several committees to be appointed to help with organization. Entertainment, and vendors are two areas we need to focus on and may need others. Tim will pin down the route hopefully starting at Boondocks and ending at Crockett Park in Brentwood. Jim Colvin will help with the permits to use the park. Leo will be on the vendor committee as well as securing insurance. Leo will use 100 riders for quoting purposes. Tim has a local contact he can send to get the one day policy in place. The entertainment may include Jamie O'Neal as well as talent from Special Olympics. Brent will reach out to that organization. MADD and THP will hopefully be involved but the trial will need to conclude first. The trial starts 02/14/2022. Adam can assist with entertainment. Jeff Carson is a possibility for entertainment also.

We will go ahead and pick a rain date in case of bad weather. That will depend on the availability of the park and Boondocks. We plan on having tshirts, and hats to sell at the ride in simple colors. The event will begin at 8 am with an 11 am kickstands up start. The ride is approximately an hour so food will need to be ready by 12:15. Water will be needed at the start and finish to ensure a successful ride and the safety of the riders.

We will look into getting some sponsors such as Brentwood Market and Costco to donate money to help get the event going. There is an organization of retired NY officers called Iron Horse who may have some money to donate and help with the event. Tim has a contact with that group.
